# Emergency Warning and Intercom System (EWIS)



### Crown Perth has an Emergency Warning and Inter-Communications System (EWIS) in place:

## ALERT Signal

When the ALERT signal is sounding (an audible and continuous 'BEEP...BEEP'), you must follow all directions given by Crown staff or emergency services

## EVACUATION Signal

When the EVACUATION signal is sounding (an audible and continuous 'WHOOP...WHOOP'), you must immediately leave the building via the nearest safety exit and follow all directions

## **Emergency Systems**



#### For your safety, Crown Perth has the following emergency systems in place:

- Fire detection and fire suppression system
- Fully automated fire alarm system that immediately calls the Fire Brigade and alerts Crown Security
- Emergency response team
- Emergency evacuation system
- Trained Area Wardens
- Medic team
- In the event of an evacuation, our trained staff will direct you to the nearest safety exit and assembly area
- Please take note of the emergency exits around the room and outside area

## Stage of Evacuation



#### Stage 1: Alert

Prepare and muster for an evacuation

### Stage 2: Evacuation

Evacuate the building and go to assigned assembly area number 8 (car park 6). Once you have left the building and arrived at the assembly area, please remain there until advised if it is safe to return

### Stage 3: All Clear

Safe to re-enter the building

#### DO NOT RETURN TO THE BUILDING UNTIL THE ALL CLEAR IS GIVEN
